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What is the Purpose of this fund?	The purpose of the program is to improve the quality and effectiveness of teachers, principals, and other school leaders; increase the number of teachers, principals, and other school leaders who are effective in improving student academic achievement in schools; and provide low-income and minority students greater access to effective teachers, principals, and other school leaders.
What is included in the BPS Grant Application?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Supporting teachers in getting advanced and comprehensive training through college courses that support a degree or certifications in Special Education, Gifted Education, Bilingual, TESOL, Teaching of Reading, Teaching of Math, and STEM classes. 2. Providing a strong mentorship program for new teacher and for Principals, utilizing peer or contracted mentors. 3. Assist local candidates and teachers on alternative licensure paths to complete the required coursework to obtain regular certification. Assist all other teachers in obtaining their National Board Licensure through mentorships and training.
